MCI PROCEDURE

FOG #5A

- Don the appropriate vest and use the radio designation "Communication."
- Establish early contact with Medical Control (Medcom/MRCC).
- Advise Medical Control of the overall situation (e.g., smoke inhalation, trauma, burns, hazardous materials exposure) and of the number and priority of victims.
- Medical Control will gather hospital capabilities and capacities. Document this hospital information on the Hospital Capability Worksheet.
- When units are prepared to transport, advise Medical Control and supply the following information:
 - a) The unit transporting
 - b) The number of victims to be transported
 - c) Their priority: Red = Immediate
 Yellow = Delayed
 Green = Ambulatory (minor)
 - d) Any special-needs victims, cardiac cases, burns, trauma, etc.
- Ground-transported victims should be assigned to hospitals on a rotating basis.
- Notify the hospital(s) of hazardous materials/WMD exposure and any antidotes given.
